As such we take our responsibilities to our animals seriously. We home check with great care for every animal that we rehome. Please contact us if you meet the following criteria to offer an animal a forever home.

- You can afford to feed, vaccinate and treat an animal in case of illness.
- You have the time and ability to exercise/train the animal.
- You have a fully enclosed private garden
- You have no children under 5 years in the household.
- There is someone at home for a large proportion of the day.

Friends of the animals are funded purely by donations from the public and therefore we ask for a minimum donation of £140 for the adoption of a dog. The charity will spay/neuter, inoculate, de-flea, worm and microchip all dogs that we rehome if this has not already been done. This is included in the above donation. The charity can also help with discounted neutering and spaying for many other types of animals.
